



The University of the West Indies English Language Requirements

Applicants from non-English speaking countries, or whose first language is not English, are asked to provide satisfactory evidence of competence in the language. To meet our English language requirements, you should have:

- Scored a minimum total of 6.5 on the University of Cambridge IELTS (International English language Testing System) OR
- Scored a minimum of 500 (paper-based) or 82* (computer-based) on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) exam.
