Chart 1. Graduates 2007-08




Chart 3. Part-Time Students




Chart 5. Registration by Sex




Chart 2. Full-Time Students




Chart 4. Off-Campus Students





Chart 6. Registration by Nationality

Chart 7. Full-Time Academic Staff




Chart 8. Full-Time Academic Staff by Rank




Chart 9. Full-Time Academic Staff by Educational Qualifications





Chart 10. Full-Time Academic Staff by Country of Origin
