Chart 1. Graduates 2007-08

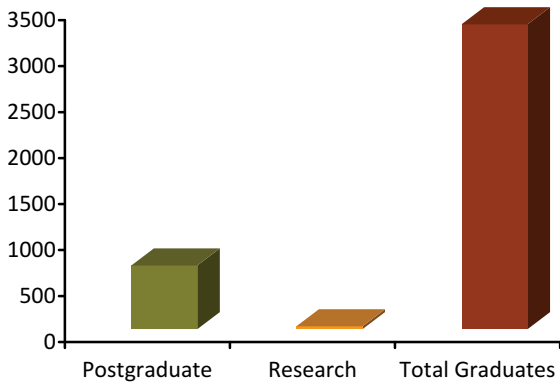


Chart 2. Full-Time Students

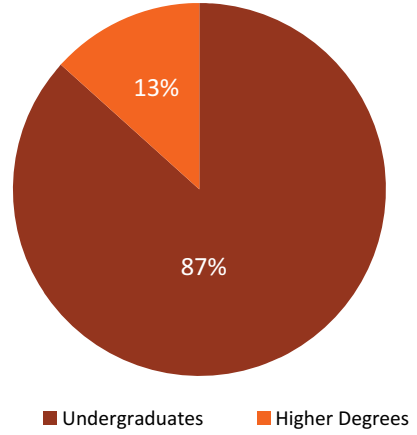


Chart 3. Part-Time Students

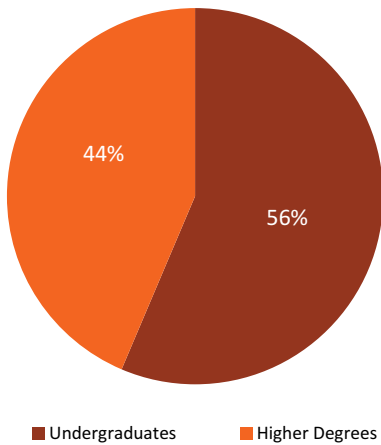


Chart 4. Off-Campus Students

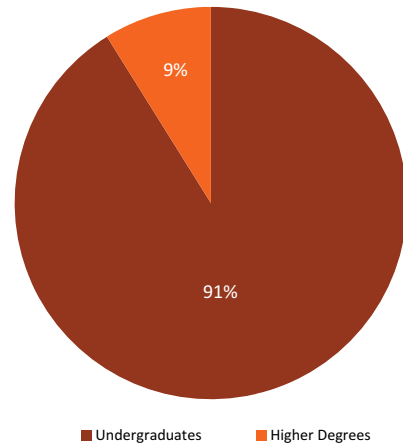


Chart 5. Registration by Sex

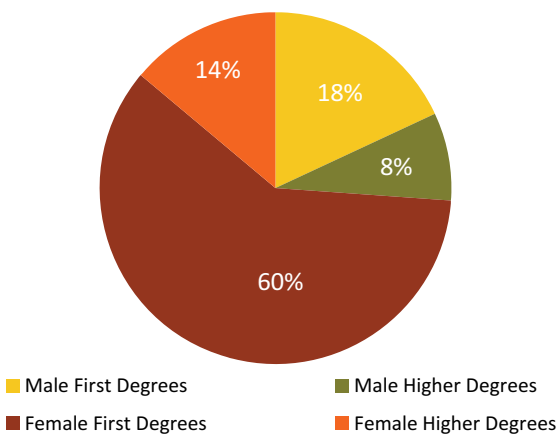
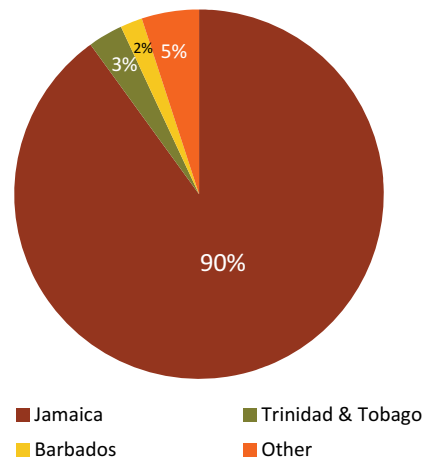
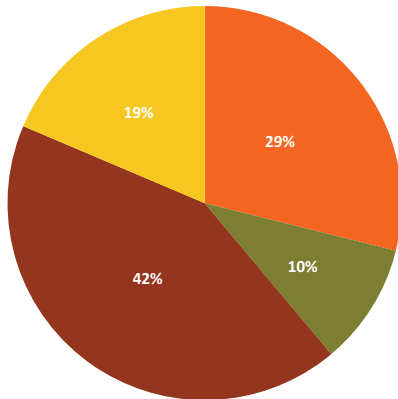


Chart 6. Registration by Nationality



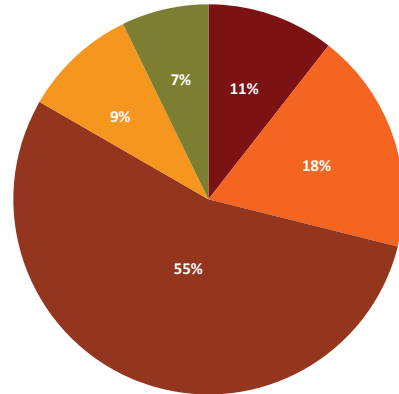

Chart 7. Full-Time Academic Staff



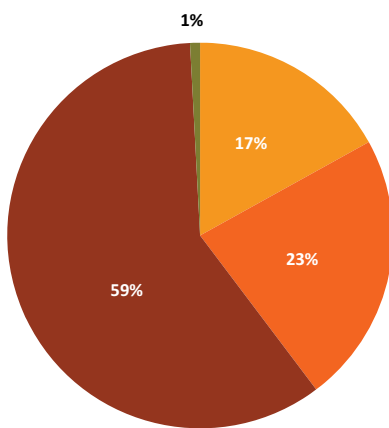

Chart 8. Full-Time Academic Staff by Rank



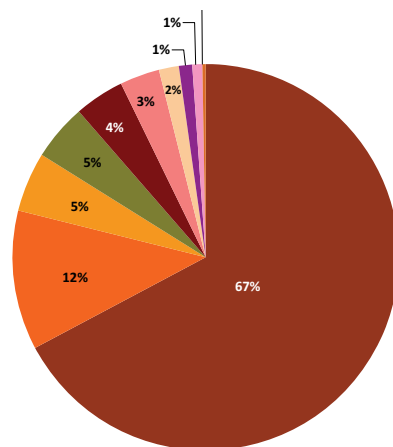
